### **Student Managers**

The role of the Student Manager is very similar to that of the form tutor in secondary school and will be your first point of contact should you wish to discuss any college related matters. If you have any information about your young person that you feel we should be aware of or you would just like to introduce yourself, you will have the opportunity to discuss this with them during our Parents Welcome Event.

### **Parents Welcome Event 2024, Wednesday 25 September, 4.30pm-7pm**

Our annual Parents Welcome Event is on Wednesday 25 September and is your chance to meet your young person's Student Manager. In order for the College to provide information to you about your young person we need their permission. Permission can be granted through your young person's student account. If permission is in place, your young person will be able to make your appointment during their weekly tutorial session. Appointments will be available between 4.30pm and 7pm. Appointments will take place onsite or via Zoom/Teams. Alternatively, you can arrange a telephone conversation, if this is more convenient. Please note that subject teachers will not be attending this event, but they will contribute to a Progress Report that will be available on ProPortal in November.

### **ProPortal for Parents**

If your young person has granted permission, you can access live information regarding their performance at college by accessing 'ProPortal'. This service contains useful information including current attendance levels, exam entries, enrolments, targets set and comments made by staff. Within the next few weeks, you will receive a text message containing login details and instructions explaining how to create your 'ProPortal' account. If you do not receive this text, please contact your young person's Student Manager who will confirm your contact details and request the text to be resent.

## Industry Placements & Work Experience

Industry placements and work-related activities at Preston College provide our students with an introduction to the world of work which helps them to develop the essential skills for their future careers.

Students undertaking an industry placements or work experience receive support before, during and after their placement, including how to identify suitable placements. Students are welcome to source their own placements and will be given advice about how to do this effectively. The College will check that employers have up-to-date Employers Liability Insurance and undertake a health and safety appraisal. All students who attend an external work placement will be issued with a work booklet, which can be accessed via our online Student Handbook.

If your young person is in receipt of Free College Meals, they will be entitled to receive an equivalent payment while on placement. A payment will be paid by BACS into their account once they have submitted their fully completed work booklet. If your young person receives support in accessing their classes in college, they will continue to be supported within their placement.

The College will assume that you are happy for your young person to attend an external work placement (where appropriate), if you have any questions regarding this process or would like to discuss this further, please contact our Work Placement Team on 01772 225078.
